Describe what you plan to sell:

We will be selling out of the Pine Forest Charter School east parking lot. Set up will start at 7:30am, please do not arrive later 8:30am. The market will run from 9am to 1pm. Please plan to stay for the full duration of the market. We will have a portable restroom again this season and we will be sharing the parking lot with the Flagstaff Mountain Town Market which will organize non-gardening related vendors. If you are a non-gardening vendor please email flagstaffmountaintownmarket@gmail.com. May 23rd we will not hold a Gardeners Market since most garden vendors will be selling at the Master Gardener Sale at MNA. You are welcome to sell with the Mountain Town Market that day if you choose.

There will be a regular Community Booth this season were growers can drop off goods to be sold if they don't have the time, energy or man power to be at the market. If you would like to utilize the Community Booth please circle the dates you plan to bring goods and specify in the "What you plan to sell space" that you want to sell via the Community Booth. Goods will need to be labeled and inventoried. At the end of the market you will need to come re-inventory and pick up your goods. The market will take 20% of the gross income which will be put directly in a fund to cover costs for the 2027 Market. Your profits will be paid to you directly at the end of the market. Community Booth vendors will no be required to volunteer time.

Fees: This season we have received a City of Flagstaff Sustainability Grant so participation is free! Once your application is accepted we will reserve a 10'x10' for you, if you need more space than that

please let me know. Each vendor will have space to park behind their booth. Please let me know if you plan to participate as soon as possible so we can maximize participation and include your farm/business in advertising.

There will be a free Community Workshop at 10am during each market in May, if you are willing to provide one of these workshops as your market service hour please list your possible available dates and topic below. Please only offer to provide a workshop if you have a solid knowledge base on the topic.
